REPORT ON THE PROPOSED APPOINTMENT OF THE DEPUTY POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER FOR SOUTH WALES

Background

This report is made in accordance with the Panel's statutory duty contained in Schedule 1 10(3) & 10(4) to the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011. Under the Act the Panel must make a report to the Commissioner and the report must include a recommendation as to whether or not the candidate should be appointed.

Review of Proposed appointment of the Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner.

The Police and Crime Commissioner for South Wales notified the Panel on 11th January 2016 of the proposed appointment of the Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner for South Wales.
