There is a duty to **inform us in writing** of any **changes to your notification**, within one month of it occurring.

You must also inform the council in writing if the **unit “ceases to be”** *Regulation 3 (4)* although there is no need to inform us of a suspended operation for the purpose of maintenance or seasonal shutdown *Regulation 3 (5)*.
