## REPORT ON THE POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER FOR SOUTH WALES' PROPOSED PRECEPT FOR 2013/14

### Background

This report is made in accordance with the South Wales Police and Crime Panel's ("SWPCP") statutory duty contained in, Schedule 5, Paragraph 3(2) of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 ("the Act"). The Panel must make a report to the Police and Crime Commissioner on the proposed precept.

### Review of Proposed Precept for 2013/14

The Police and Crime Commissioner for South Wales notified the SWPCP on 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2013 of the Precept Proposal for 2013/14

Approve the proposed Precept of £84,365,530 which is £181.28 (for a Band D property) for 2013/14 and a 7% increase.

The Police and Crime Commissioner for South Wales provides the SWPCP with regular reports concerning in particular the Partnership Development Fund and the use of the precept monies in furtherance of the Policing Plan.
