On **25**<sup>th</sup> **May 2011**, Merthyr Tydfil County Borough Council adopted a Local Development Plan (LDP) for the County Borough of Merthyr Tydfil excluding the area contained within the Brecon Beacons National Park. The adopted LDP will form the development plan for Merthyr Tydfil County Borough (excluding the area contained within the National Park) and will be the basis for decisions on land use planning in this area.

- Central Library, High Street, Merthyr Tydfil
- Dowlais Library, Church Street, Dowlais
- Treharris Library, Perrott Street, Treharris

The LDP became operative upon its adoption on 25<sup>th</sup> May 2011.

A person aggrieved by the LDP who desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by Part 6 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 or that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the adoption of the LDP, may, within six weeks from 9th June, make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the 2004 Act.
