### Cyflawni Mwy Gyda'n Gilydd Tuag At Dde Cymru Mwy Diogel

De Cymru yw un o'r ardaloedd mwyaf diogel i fyw a gweithio yn y DU, ond mae'r pwysau sylweddol ar blismona a gwasanaethau eraill yn ei gwneud yn angenrheidiol i ystyried yn ofalus iawn y lefel o dreth gyngor sydd ei hangen i gynorthwyo ein cymunedau.

Y canlyniad yw cynnydd ym mhraesept yr Heddlu - ond bydd deiliad tai De Cymru yn parhau i dalu'r hyn sydd ymysg y costau plismona isaf yng Nghymru gyda chynnydd o £7.99 y flwyddyn (2.2c y diwrnod) ar gyfer eiddo Band D.

Mae Comisiynydd yr Heddlu a Throseddu De Cymru wedi pennu'r dreth gyngor ar £207.85, gan gyfrannu £99m tuag at gyllideb o £258.9m ar gyfer gwasanaeth heddlu 24 awr, saith diwrnod yr wythnos.

Mae pennu'r praecept ar y lefel gywir yn gofyn am ystyriaeth ofalus iawn er mwyn cydbwyso'r angen i gadw ein cymunedau'n ddiogel â'u gallu i dalu.

Er bod setliad yr heddlu'n well na'r disgwyl, rydym yn dal i wynebu toriadau gwirioneddol o £10m. Cafodd Grant yr Heddlu ei dorri bron £1m. Ac o ganlyniad uniongyrchol i bolisi'r Llywodraeth, mae'n rhaid i ni ddod o hyd i £4.7m ar gyfer cyfraniadau Yswiriant Gwladol ychwanegol. Mae'r Llywodraeth hefyd wedi torri ein grant cyfalaf £1m ers 2014-15 ac hefyd mae effaith chwyddiant. Bydd y praecept ond yn mynd i'r afael â rhan o'r bwlch hwn, ynghyd ag arbedion effeithlonrwydd eleni o £5.3m ar ben y £39m o arbedion a gyflawnwyd yn llwyddianus ers 2010.

Bydd y cynnydd gweddol fach hwn o 4% yn y praecept yn galluogi Heddlu De Cymru i gynnal niferoedd swyddogion yr heddlu ar gyfer y flwyddyn sydd i ddod.

Nod Cynllun yr Heddlu a Gostwng Troseddu 2016-21 yw diogelu ein pobl a gweithio hyd yn oed yn agosach gyda phobl leol. Lluniwyd y Cynllun ar y cyd â'r Prif Gwnstabl ac mae'n nodi ein gweledigaeth ar gyfer plismona yn Ne Cymru. Mae'n rhoi pwyslais clir ar ymyriadau cynnar a gweithredu prydion, cadarnhaol. Mae'r Cynllun yn nodi sut y bydd Heddlu De Cymru yn ymateb i fygythiadau cynyddol megis trosedd ar-lein a chamfanteisio'n rhywiol ar blant.

### Achieving More Together Towards a Safer South Wales

South Wales is one of the safest areas to live and work in the UK but the intense pressure on policing and other services makes it necessary to give very careful consideration to the level of council tax needed to support our communities.

The result is an increase in the Police precept - but householders in South Wales will continue to pay amongst the lowest costs for policing in Wales with an increase of £7.99 a year (2.2p a day) for Band D properties.

The Police and Crime Commissioner for South Wales, has set the council tax at £207.85, contributing £99m towards the £258.9m budget for a 24 hour, seven day a week police service.

Setting the precept at the right level requires a great deal of careful consideration in order to balance the need to keep our communities safe with their ability to pay.

While the police settlement was better than we had feared, we still face real terms cuts of £10m. Police Grant has been cut by nearly £1m. And as a direct result of Government policy, we have to find £4.7m for increased National Insurance contributions. The Government has also cut our capital grant by £1m since 2014-15 and there is the impact of inflation. The precept will address only part of this gap, along with efficiency savings this year of £5.3m on top of the £39m of savings successfully delivered since 2010.

This modest increase in the precept of 4% will enable South Wales Police to maintain police officer numbers for the coming year.

The Police and Crime Reduction Plan 2016-21 is about protecting our people and working ever more closely with local communities. The Plan has been produced in close co-operation with the Chief Constable and sets out a vision for policing in South Wales. It provides a clear emphasis on early intervention and prompt, positive action. The Plan sets out how South Wales Police will respond to growing threats such as internet enabled crime and child sexual exploitation.

Cyllideb y rhaglen gyfalaf ar gyfer 2016-17 yw £16.5 miliwn. Daw'r cyllid o grant cyfalaf y Swyddfa Gartref, £1.1 miliwn, a benthyca allanol o £1.7 miliwn, gan olygu bod angen cyllid mewnlaf neu gyfalaf wrth gefn o £13.7 miliwn.

Ym mis Mawrth 2015, roedd £9 miliwn o gyfalaf wrth gefn, sef y lefel isaf a argymhellir.

The Capital programme budget for 2016-17 is £16.5m. Funding is made available from Home Office capital grant £1.1m and external borrowing of £1.7m, meaning internal financing or capital reserves of £13.7m are required.

As at March 2015, the general reserve held was £9m, which is the recommended minimum level.
