COMMENT

A number of routes could link Pentrebach / Abercanaid / Troedyrhiw. The South Wales Metro will be the catalyst for redevelopment of the former Hoover site (and wider area) for a sustainable, mixed use neighbourhood. Initial conceptual work has indicated that the strategic regeneration area will support transport infrastructure (including a new metro station and park and ride facility, and links to the Active Travel network); an element of retail provision; employment land; and up to 1000

dwellings.
