

Key Message Q4 17/18

The last meeting of Cwm Taf Regional Collaborative Committee took place on the 28th March 2018. Various items were discussed including Funding Flexibilities. In April 2018, Welsh Government launched a pilot project allowing selected Local Authorities to move funds between a number of existing grants, including the Supporting People Programme Grant. Welsh Government have selected both Merthyr Tydfil and Rhondda Cynon Taf to become two of seven 'full flexibility pathfinder authorities', making Cwm Taf the only pathfinder region in Wales. This will allow Cwm Taf Regional Collaborative Committee to explore opportunities for collaboration across the region and across funding streams to further improve services to vulnerable people in Cwm Taf. Both Local Authorities are keen to maximise the opportunities presented by this pilot and have submitted single delivery plans which have been accepted by Welsh Government.
