

Cwm Taf RCC Q4 Key Message

The Cwm Taf Regional Collaborative Committee met on Monday 11th February. Members agreed to adopt the new name of Cwm Taf Morgannwg RCC to reflect the new regional footprint. A Supporting People Contract Monitoring Officers Group has been established to share best practice, explore regional opportunities and share information across the three Local Authority teams.

Supporting People Lead Officers from Merthyr Tydfil and Rhondda Cynon Taf were pleased to confirm that the final report on hostel provision in the two authority areas had been received from the consultants. Work will now commence to address the recommendations with a view to regionally commission from April 2020.

The new jointly commissioned dementia scheme will provide Housing Related Support to people aged 50+ with a dementia diagnosis in Merthyr Tydfil and Rhondda Cynon Taf and will be delivered by Care and Repair from April 2019.

The RCC have been successful in their bid to work with University of South Wales media students to create a promotional film. Filming will take place in March 2019 to include Service User stories from all three Local Authority areas with an estimated completion date of Mid May.
