Do you require housing related support?


If so Supporting People Services could help.

Supporting People (SP) Services can provide help and support with the following:

- Budgeting
- Debt issues
- Maximising income and paying bills
- Liaising with appropriate professionals
- Advising how to keep the property safe and secure.
- Daily living skills

Available Support Services

Supporting People (SP) primarily funds two categories of support; Supported Accommodation and Floating Support. SP services support people with a range of needs including:

- Homelessness
 - Domestic Abuse
 - Mental Health
 - Young People
 - Learning disabilities
 - Older People

How do I get a Service?

To access any of the Supporting People Services an application for the **Single Access Point** must be completed and returned to the team. You can complete a form yourself or contact the Supporting People Team on 01685 724690.

If you have support from another organisation/agency, they can complete this form with you.

If you are completing this form on behalf of someone else please discuss the referral with them and ensure that they are happy to receive support.


