

## **HWRCS SITE RULES DURING COVID-19**



- 1. You must stick to the site's traffic management rules at ALL times.
- 2. During busy periods and where queues are impacting the traffic management system, you may be asked to return later.
- 3. All items and materials need to be sorted in to waste types, e.g. wood, plastic, metal, glass etc. before entering **NO mixed recycling is accepted**.
- 4. Only a limited number of vehicles will be permitted on to the site at any one time.
- Be prepared to show proof of residency to gain entry, such as a **Driving Licence or** utility bill.
- 6. During extremely busy periods you may not be able to join the queue after 4pm.
- 7. When queuing you **MUST NOT get out of your vehicle**. If you do you will be asked to leave the site.
- 8. Stay inside your car until you are asked to get out.
- 9. Only one person may leave the car to unload.
- 10. **Staff are unable to help unload or lift any items** so please bear this in mind when attending the site.
- 11. You have a maximum of 10 minutes to dispose of your items.
- 12. You MUST observe strict 2-metre social distancing rules at ALL times.
- 13. **Please respect our staff.** Anyone being abusive to staff will be instructed to leave the site.
- 14. Please be patient. There may be long queues at times.
- 15. The van permit scheme is in operation but residents WILL be asked to provide proof of residency. Maximum of 3 permits per day and 6 per year.
- 16. Community Recycling Centres are only licensed to accept household waste. No trade waste will be accepted at any of our sites.
- 17. Smoking is not permitted onsite.
- 18. If you've had symptoms of Coronavirus or have had a positive test result then you MUST NOT use the HWRCS for a minimum of 14 days.
- 19. Remember to wash your hands thoroughly after leaving the site.

Together with your cooperation we can maintain an efficient waste and recycling service for everyone.
