PHASE B INVOLVEMENT (FORMULATION & CONSULTATION)

EPS Referral Required via PORTAL (Including Evidence of School Response at Phase A)

EPS Consultation & Review with

School Staff, Parents/Carers, Pupils and /or Profes-

Team Around The Child Meeting

Or

Multi Agency Meeting

Record of Phase B involvement to be recorded by the EP and shared with school / family / professional

Points to Consider at Review

PHASE C INVOLVEMENT: INTERVENTION & ASSESSMENT

Nature of Phase C involvement MUST be agreed with EP

Direct Assessment

Therapeutic Intervention

Record of Phase C involvement to be written up by the Psychologist and shared with school / family / professionals./

Feedback to pupils to be given in the form of a Therapeutic Letter

Points to Consider at Review
