The COVID pandemic has had a particularly detrimental effect on many of the families within our community. As a volunteer I worked alongside my fellow Independent Gurnos Councillor, Lee Davies, and with other volunteers of the Gurnos Men's Project to access funding to enable us to deliver 1000's of food parcels, household packs

and activities packs, as well as delivering online well-being activities to some of the most vulnerable members of our Community. We would also make weekly calls, and liaise with other services for them where needed.

As Gurnos Ward Councillors we have supported a number of Gurnos community groups with over £25k in Ffos-y-fran funding to enable them continue delivering their activities. We are also extremely passionate about the environment, and have raised funds and worked in partnership with many organisations to carry out many projects (such as tree & bulb planting, wildflower cultivation, development of Honeysuckle Park and the new Marsh Fields area next to Prince Charles Hospital). We also have organised and volunteered on many community litter-picks. As part of an Independent Council, we have also been able to scrap all pitch fees for sports clubs until 2026, as well as a committed investment in new playgrounds across the Borough.

As you can see I have a proven track record of supporting the Community, and if elected, I promise that I will continue to give 100% effort to support the community. Please vote DAVIES in this the Gurnos Ward elections on the 5th May 2022.
