- ✓ **Ysgol y Graig** – Finally after years of fighting to retain and build a new school our dreams came true, and the school opened its doors in September 2021 on the old Vaynor and Penderyn site!
- ✓ **Road Safety** – two new lighted speed awareness signs in Cefn Coed, new road markings on the A470 approaching Llwyn On.
- ✓ **Potholes** – Action taken to report Potholes during our ward checks and responding to residents' queries. Many parts of the ward roads have been resurfaced with more scheduled.
- ✓ **Housing** – taking immediate action to support residents with housing issues, personal concerns, disabled facilities, Anti-Social behaviour etc. working with partners such as Merthyr Valley Homes and South Wales Police.
- ✓ **Enhancing our surroundings** – Planting in all parts of the ward, including spring bulbs, trees, and flower boxes. Reporting and dealing with fly tipping. Installation of new Dog Bins in the ward incl Taff Trail, Llwyn On, Trefechan. Carrying out Litter picks. Our Annual Christmas Tree event.
- ✓ **Supporting** – Numerous groups and organisations with Biffa and Ffos y Fran funding to help them provide services in the ward such as Trefechan Pre-school, Cefn Community centre, Pontsticill memorial hall, Pontsticill community Group, St Gwynno's church to name but a few.
- ✓ **Playgrounds** – New upgraded playground for Charlies Park, Supporting the Pontsticill Community Group with funds to enhance the playground in Pontsticill and currently have an application in to upgrade Trefechan Playground!

On a personal note: I have continued to ensure the residents of Vaynor ward have my full support, I volunteered throughout the pandemic providing and delivering food parcels to all those in need, we did book trails with the support of Stephens and George Charitable Trust during Easter, Summer Holidays etc. I delivered surprises for those in the ward feeling lonely and isolated as well as many families with activity parks for the children and equipment to help them grown their own and cook at home focusing on Health and Wellbeing. As many know I have lived in Vaynor all my life, I went to school locally. I have two children James and Beth. I'm a committed, dedicated person always keen to address people's issues and improve our community to make it a better place to live.
