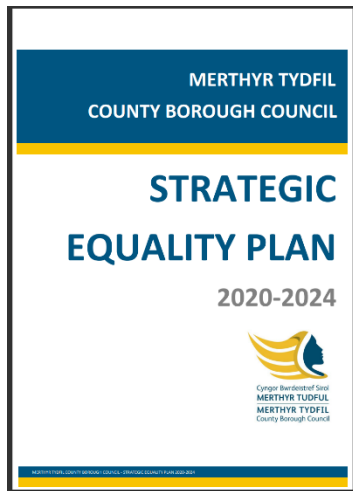
We need to make sure our services;

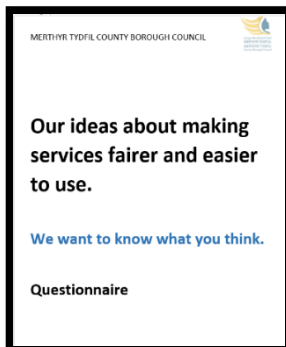
